Mwanga District Council has received funds under the Water Sector Development Programme (WSDP) towards the cost of Technical and Facilitation Services for Rural Water Supply and Sanitation Subprojects, And *grant* from the AfDB towards the Construction of two water supply schemes in two drought prone villages (Makuyuni and Jipe) of Mwanga District and it intends to apply part of the proceeds of this fund/*grant* to cover eligible payments under the contract for which this invitation for bids is issued as detailed bellow:

3. The Mwanga District Council now invites sealed Tenders from eligible contractors registered or capable of being registered in *Class Six and above*

for carrying out **Construction of pumped water scheme at Simbomu Village**. The works include:

- Construction of 50m³ storage tank on ground
- Construction of one pump house
- Construction 5 domestic points
- Excavation of trenches of 2800m³
- Construction of 1BPT
- Supply and installations of Submersible pump
- Supply and installations of pipe and fittings

And The Construction of two water supply schemes in two drought prone villages (Makuyuni and Jipe) of Mwanga district. The works consists of

- Supply pipes, lay in trenches and backfilling pipes for transmission and distribution mains with total length of 23,500Metres
- Supply and installing pipes, valves, fittings and specials.
- Construction of two (2) storage tanks on ground of 50 m³ and 45m³ at two villages.
- Construction of 12 domestic points.
- Rehabilitation of one tank at Jipe Village
- 4. Tendering will be conducted through the National Competitive Bid specified in the Public Procurement Regulations, Government Notice No.446 of 2013 and is open to all Tenderers as defined in the Regulations unless otherwise stated in the Tender Data Sheet.

- 7. All Bids must be accompanied by a Bid Securing Declaration in the format provided in the Bidding documents.

All bids in one original plus **two copies**, properly filled in, and enclosed in plain envelopes must be delivered to the address below at or before *10.30 local times on Tuesday 4th June*, *2019*. Bids will be opened promptly thereafter in public and in the presence of Bidders' representatives who choose to attend in the opening at the *Mwanga District Council Hall*.
